

Telegram from the President of the Government of Spain to

H.E. Mr. Narendra Modi
Prime Minister of India
New Delhi

Dear Prime Minister,

I write to you appalled by the attacks perpetrated yesterday, 10 July, close to Anantnag, that caused at least 7 mortal victims and left over 30 injured.

I would like to express, on behalf of the Government of Spain and on my own behalf, our outrage and absolute condemnation of these abhorrent acts, and our most sincere condolences to the families and friends of the victims, together with our wishes for a quick recovery to the injured; which we request you to convey to the families of the victims.

In these moments of pain caused by this barbaric act committed for religious motives, I would like to convey the solidarity of the Government and the people of Spain, and reiterate our condemnation to all types of terrorism. India can count on Spain in the fight against terrorism.

I avail myself of this opportunity to express the assurances of my highest consideration and esteem.
